Reflections of OLDE ...on the Belgrave –Gembrook Line 2004-2005

[Includes]Gembrook Mixed 2004 On the 24th July 2004, the first mixed goods train for 51 years ran to Gembrook. Locomotive 12A was Grimed-up' with the addition of drag chains and loco jacks to recreate that authentic early 1950s look. The train made many photo stops along the way. **5A on the Olde Gembrook Pass;** After the first successful Olde Gembrook Passenger train earlier in 2005, a second trip was run on the 17th November. This was loco 14A and was renumbered 5A for the haul. **Return of 1NB;** on 20th Dec. 2005, historic carriage 1NB returned to the rails, following a lengthy restoration and was second in a consist on some roofed carriages on the Olde Gembrook Pass style train.
